THE SCHOOL TIMING:



EXAMINATION AND EVALUATION SYSTEM

GRADE V

4 written examinations in a year of 50 marks each.

- 1. Unit Test 1 in the month of July
- 2. Unit Test 2 in the month of September
- 3. Unit Test 3 in the month of December
- 4. Unit Test 4 in the month of March



SCHEME OF ASSESSMENT

- 1. 100 mrks of each Unit Test is divided into half.
- 2. 50 for written test and 50 for internal assessment.
- 3. Internal assessment consists of project work for 25 mrks and Lab or Map activity for 25 mrks.
- 4. Student has to secure 33% marks in all the written assessments in each subject.
- 5. Marks and grades will be awarded for individual subjects.



EXAMINATION AND EVALUATION SYSTEM

GRADE VI- VIII

Assessment will be conducted twice:

- 1. Half Yearly Exam in the month of October.
- 2. Final Exam in the month of March.
- 3. Under internal assessments there will be Subject Enrichment activity and Notebook Submission at term end for each subject.



SCHEME OF ASSESSMENT

Half yearly exam and Final Exam is divided into 80 mrks and 20 mrks, where 80 marks is written paper and 20 marks is subdived into 10+5+5+80=100

- 2. SUBJECT ENRICHMENT includes project work, lab activities, assignment for. (5 marks)
- 3. Notebook work and maintenance- for (5 marks)
- 4. Half yearly / final exam- (80 marks)
- 5. Student has to secure 33% marks in all the written assessments in each subject.
- 6. Marks and grades will be awarded for individual subjects.
