


EXAMINATION AND EVALUATION SYSTEM

GRADE IX & X

For Grades IX-XII there will be 3 Periodic Tests and the Final examination in the month of February for Grade IX and for Grade X as per the CBSE guidelines .

For Grades IX & X for the internal assessments there will be Subject Enrichment activity and Notebook Submission at term end for each subject.





SCHEME OF ASSESSMENT

- 1. For Grades IX –XII, all assessments will be conducted considering the cumulative portions in each subject and 100% syllabus for the final examination.
- 2. For Grades IX-XII there will be 3 Periodic Tests and the Final examination in the month of February for Grade IX.
- 3. For Grades IX-X, 20 marks will be awarded from the school for each subject considering the internal assessment.(Periodic Tests, Notebook submission & Subject Enrichment Activity).
- 4. Student has to secure 33% marks in all the written assessments in each subject.
- 5. Marks and grades will be awarded for individual subjects.
- 6. The yearly exam for Grade X & XII will be conducted by the CBSE Board.
